

COMING SATURDAY, MARCH 18TH 9AM-NOON

KUSAMONO WORKSHOP

I am so excited to present the March Club Program where we build or own Kusamono based on what Young Choe taught us in the February program. We did restrict the number of participants to 24 for this workshop so everyone that wanted can have fun. I have 19 signed up. If you wish to participate, call me or email me to sign up. You may pay the \$20 on the day of the meeting.

To participate, you are required to do 4 things.

1. Collect and bring 3 'weeds' growing wherever you find them. Hopefully you picked up the containers that were provided, but if you didn't, simply use a plastic or paper water cup with holes in the bottom. These are to go on the share table so bring extra if you want to keep what you find.
2. Make or bring your own 2 pots. One pot will hold the moss ball creation and the other pot will hold the larger Kusamono creation. Seven people showed up at my house to make their own pots. All others must bring their own. Remember that the pot for the Kusamono must be around 6" by 1" deep. Shape doesn't matter. For the Kokedama Kusamono the object may be flat if you choose.
3. Bring scissors and a wire cutter and a chop stick.
4. Pay the \$20 fee to cover materials such as: soil, muck, screen, wire, plants etc. I will bring those.

All plants will go on a table, and you will have time to look them over. All participants will receive a number. When the number is called, you will go and choose your plants. DON'T lose your number as we will use them twice.

All participants are expected to cover their table and sit in the front area of the room marked for workshop participants. Cover your table with plastic and clean up your area when done.

If we finish in time, I will show you how to make the Moss Ball Kokedama. If we have plenty of time, you will be able to make one.
