## ANNUAL SHOW NOVEMBER 12-13, 2022

It's time to step up to participate in The Big Show. We want every member to play a part. We hope each of you will submit one or more trees for the exhibition, and we need the involvement of every member for the mechanics of the show.

Work begins on Friday November 11 with setup and ends with dismantling after the show closes on Sunday afternoon, November 13. There's a job for everyone, from able-bodied to able-minded. Please join us in making our club shine and in welcoming others to enjoy our art. We have a reputation to uphold. **We're known as one of the best clubs in the state**, and we want to remain worthy of that renown.

During the show there will be many simultaneous activities on each day, Saturday November 12 and Sunday November 13. Here are the jobs that need filling:

- a. **Program**: Dave and Martha will be preparing for and organizing the program. We will need a few people to help with cleanup and setup after each program is done.
- b. **Raffle**: Dave oversees the raffle. Any Bonsai-related donations to this major raffle are greatly appreciated. We will also have a \$5 and \$10 table much like we did at the auction. Donations will be great. It should all be bonsai related. Dave will also need people to help with the raffle. Sign up.
- c. **Vendors**: All the work by club members is done on Friday to set up and Sunday to tear down. No extra help is needed for vendors during the show.
- d. **Exhibit**: We want every member to show a tree. Phil Krieg oversees the exhibit area. Setup is critical and happens on Friday during setup. Phil will be handing out a paper to sign up for showing your tree. He will announce a deadline to receive this information. It's time to declare your intent. Jaye Saarinen oversees Docents and will have a signup sheet at our September meeting. He will need one or two people to oversee the exhibit for several hours at a time. Please sign up.



- e. **Greeters:** Jaye is also in charge of the Greeter function. Greeters are the one or two members who sit at the two entrances to welcome people and hand out programs, etc. This is also done on a time schedule. Sign up.
- f. **Hospitality:** We will probably be asking everyone to bring food to share with everyone there. This is not sure yet, but it needs someone in charge, with three or four to help organize. Please sign up.

Start looking for moss. Know where to go when it is time to prepare your tree for the show. There are several places where you can buy moss, but finding a local area is great if possible. Be prepared.
